Narrative:

Sergeant Steve Vallance, Officer Joe McGrade and I responded to the area of MacIntosh School in reference to a vehicle that drove through the parking lot trying to hit the construction workers tearing down the school. They were able to get the license plate number of [REDACTED] on tan Ford. Dispatch said the license plate returned to [REDACTED] West 15th Street apartment [REDACTED]. Sergeant Vallance went and spoke to the construction the crews and Officer McGrade and I went looking for the vehicle. I went to Mrs. [REDACTED]'s apartment but did not see the car in the parking lot. I went up to the apartment and rang the door bell. No one answered the door. I left a Please Contact the Police Department card on the door. Everyone went back in service.

I went back by the apartment later in the shift and saw a tan Ford Tarsus parked in the parking lot by the apartment. I pulled in and checked the license plate which was [REDACTED]. I went to the apartment and range to door bell. A woman answered the door and I asked her if she was [REDACTED]. She said yes. I asked her if I could step in and talk to her. She stepped out and closed the door behind her. She was eating her microwave meal while standing there. I asked her if she knew why I was there. She said yes. I asked her why she tried to run over the construction crews. She said "They should be run over". I asked her why and she said because they are tearing down the school. I explained to her that the crew did not decide to tear down the school someone else did. She said that they were getting paid \$300,000 to tear it down. I again explained to her that it was not their doing. She argued about how 5 people run this county and that no one can change that. I explained the election process and that she could change it. She yelled not before they tear it down. I gave her a trespass warning for the property and explained that she will be arrested if she goes back there and that she could be charged for trying to run over the construction crew. She did not seem to care. I went back in service and went to the Prosecutor's office. I discussed the matter with Don Shivley and he said he would get back to me about charges. Incident complete.
